Funeral services for Jack Karl Love, age 61, were held at the Platte Funeral Chapel Thursday, Nov. 1, at 2 p.m., with Pastor Fred Tuberville officiating. Mr. Love died Saturday, Oct. 27 at his home in Wheatland.

Jack Karl Love was born Feb. 25, 1929, at Mokane, Mo., the son of George Washington and Sarah C. (Kuckler) Love. He was reared and educated in Missouri, graduating from high school in 1947. In 1948, he moved to Denver, and worked for the Denver Department of Water Works as a foreman of transportation and heavy equipment operator.

On Jan. 10, 1950, he married Bonnie J. Capps in Denver. They remained in Denver until 1979 when they moved to Wyoming, and he went to work for the Wyoming Highway Department at the Shirley Rim, where he remained until January, 1990.

In June of this year, the couple moved to Wheatland. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge.

He is survived by his wife, Bonnie, of the home, a son, Bob Love, of Wheatland, and a daughter, Joan Busskohl of Edgerton. Also surviving are three brothers, Walt Love and Harold Love, both of Denver, and Herman Love of Shoilite, N.C., and a sister, Nellie Simons, of Fulton, Mo. Two grandchildren also remain. He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers, one sister and one grandson.

Serving as pallbearers were Mark Capps, Larry Capps, Tim Capps, Bob Love, Pat Busskohl and Hal Busskohl.

A memorial has been established to either the Wheatland Public Health Nurses or the Hospice Foundation.
