

Marilyn Kaye Loyd

Services for Marilyn Kaye Loyd, 55, were held Tuesday, April 14, 1998, at 11:00 a.m. at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Andy Gudahl, Minister officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Loyd died Thursday, April 9, 1998, in the emergency room of the Platte county Memorial Hospital from injuries sustained in a one vehicle accident.

She was born July 22, 1942, in Denver, Colo., the daughter of Merle and June (Pepmeyer) Heckard. She was reared in Fort Lupton, Colo., where she attended grade school; she graduated from Fort Collins High School in Fort Collins, Colo. in 1960. After high school, she went to Hobbs Beauty Academy in Greeley, Colo. and became a cosmetologist. She continued her education in cosmetology and obtained her instructor's and manager's certificate in cosmetology. Marilyn managed the Burnell College of hair Styling in Fort Collins before moving to Wheatland in 1972. She married Clint E. Loyd on August 18, 1963, in Loveland, Colo. After moving to Wheatland, Marilyn began working for Safeway Stores Inc. in 1973 and worked there until the time of her death.

She was a member of First Christian Church in Wheatland and a member of the United Food Workers Union. Marilyn enjoyed flowers, gardening, and sewing. Most of all she enjoyed her children, grandchildren, and her parents. She always put her family ahead of her own needs.

Marilyn is survived by her husband, Clint of Wheatland; four children, Duane Loyd and wife, Tam of Casper Wyo., Colette Loyd of Denver, Colo., Cynthia Loyd of Kirkland, Wash., and Chris Loyd of Wheatland; her mother, June Heckard of Fort Collins; a sister, Carol Greenwood of Denver; three grandchildren, Tyler and Savannah of Casper and Mark Edward of Denver; and several nieces and nephews.
