

MARTIN, BERRIE HELEN
September 8, 1892-February 18, 1918

The death of Miss Berry Martin from diphtheria at the home of her brother, Frost Martin, engineer at the power plant, came as a shock to the entire community.

Miss Martin had been a resident of this vicinity since early childhood, being a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Martin who were long residents of the farming community south of Wheatland. Miss Martin had taught for years in the schools of the county, and was teaching near her homestead in Goshen Hole when she was taken ill. The beginnings of the fatal malady began about two weeks ago, but Miss Martin continued at her work for several days, not realizing its seriousness. On Tuesday of last week she drove to Wheatland with her mother to be nearer to medical assistance.

She became rapidly worse after arrival, death occurring Sunday evening. A private funeral was held from the home Monday afternoon.
