

MARTIN, CHESTER GALEN
September 15, 1883-September 25, 1951

Last rites were conducted at 2:00 this afternoon (Thursday) in the Schrader chapel for Chester Galen Martin, 69, of Wheatland when he succumbed very suddenly at his home on Tuesday evening, September 25. He was sitting in a chair at the time he was stricken.

The services were in charge of the Rev. J.B. Milstead, and the Masonic lodge, of which he was a member, conducted the graveside ceremonies.

Martin was born September 15, 1883 in Park City, Mont. and for 25 years was a resident of Platte county. For 14 years he was engaged in the sheep business in this vicinity.

He was affiliated with the Masonic lodge of Chugwater and was a member of the Congregational church of Billings, Mont.
