

MATHIS, HERMAN RILEY
November 3, 1916-April 25, 1958

Herman Riley Mathis was born November 3, 1916, in Lexington, Nebraska and passed away suddenly at the Platte County Memorial Hospital April 25, 1958. Mr. Mathis became ill suddenly at his home, 6 miles northeast of Wheatland, and was rushed to the hospital the day prior to his death.

Mr. Mathis was engaged in farming and ranching and had lived in this community the past 8 years, coming from Nebraska. He was a veteran of World War II.

Besides his wife, Ruby Helen Mathis, he is survived by his mother, Mrs. Carl Mathis of Lisco, Nebr.; two sons, Douglas Herman and David Allen, at home; four brothers, Melvin, Lisco, Nebr., John, Denver, George, Alameda, Calif. and Howard of Broadwater, Nebr.; two sisters, Mrs. Helen Loghry, Lisco, Nebr. and Mrs. Dora Lloyd, Hays Springs, Nebr.
