

Pioneer Resident Of Guernsey Dies At Home Monday

12-19-1938

Swan Matson, early pioneer of Guernsey and vicinity, died at his home early Monday morning, December 19, from an acute heart attack. Mr. Matson was born January 14, 1863 in Sweden and come to the United States when a young boy. He was 75 years old at the time of his demise.

Surviving are his wife, one daughter, Mrs. Sadie Siler of Cheyenne, one granddaughter, Cynthia Siler of Cheyenne and one grandson, Raynard Siler of Aruba, Dutch West Indies.

Funeral services were held Wednesday at 1 p. m. from the Guernsey Community church with Rev. Morton officiating. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with Watson and Dennis in charge of arrangements.

Swan Matson, pioneer in the Guernsey community passed away at his home Monday Dec. 19 after an illness of one week.

Mr. Matson came to Guernsey with his wife forty years ago and settled on a homestead four miles south of the present townsite.

He was born January 14, 1863 in Sweden.

He is survived by his wife, one daughter, Mrs. Sadie Siler of Cheyenne and two grandchildren, Raynard and Cynthia Siler. His death was unexpected as he had only been ill about a week.
