The many friends of William James McBrier of Wendover were shocked to learn of his sudden death, Sunday, at his home, caused from a weak heart and influenza. The deceased was 53 years, 3 months and 10 days old at the time of his death, and was born in New York City. Mr. McBrier formerly was section foreman for the C.S. & Q. at Wendover and is well known in that vicinity. He is survived by his wife who is postmistress at Wendover and several step-children. Funeral services were held from the Watson Mortuary chapel, Wednesday afternoon with the Rev. Orman C. King preaching the funeral oration.
