

MCCALL, WILLIAM J.

A wire was received this morning by Marion Hutchinson from La Junta, Colorado stating that W. J. McCall, former well known farmer, had just died.

Mr. McCall had been in failing health for several years, and recently had entered a Pueblo hospital, where the cause of his trouble was diagnosed as a tumor on the brain. An operation was said to be his only hope, and he underwent the surgeon's knife during the first week in June. It seems that the measure was taken too late. McCall left here several years ago for Las Animas, Colo., where he lived on a homestead for several years, working in the railway shops. The body is to be shipped to Wheatland, arriving on the Tuesday morning train, for burial here.
