

MCCALLUM, ANNIE LAWSON  
February 19, 1843-January 15, 1914

Word was received in Wheatland on Wednesday telling of the death of Mrs. D. McCallum, which occurred in California, where she was taken by Mr. McCallum the first of the month in hopes that a change in climate would prove beneficial to her health. Mrs. McCallum passed away at two o'clock on Wednesday morning, Jan. 14<sup>th</sup>, death being caused by a cancerous growth in the throat.

Mrs. McCallum was one of the most estimable ladies of Wheatland, being highly respected and loved by all acquaintances. She was a tireless church worker and was ever ready and willing to lend a helping hand to the needy.

Mrs. McCallum was born in Canada and would have been 72 years of age in February. She moved to Cheyenne with her husband about 35 years ago, where they lived until they moved to Wheatland at the time the town was started 20 years ago. Besides the husband, Mayor McCallum, the deceased is survived by a son, N.J.N. McCallum, of this place. Two brothers, A. Lawson and Robt. Lawson, and two sisters, Mrs. John Chaplin and Mrs. Wm. Bruce, reside in Cheyenne. A son, Wm. McCallum, died in Cheyenne over twenty years ago.

No arrangements for the funeral have been made at the time we go to press, as no word other than the information of the death have been received from Mr. McCallum.
