

Rev. J. McCallum
**killed by lightning
June 1 in Idaho**

Rev. John Wm. McCallum of Rupert, Ida. was killed by lightning June 1 near his home. A minister of the Bible Baptist church, he was born in Wheatland on June 6, 1926 to William and Generva Cuthbertson McCallum, and had resided here until 1950. He had made his home in Rupert, Ida. for the past two and a half years. He was a veteran of World War II.

Graveside services were conducted at the Wheatland cemetery on Wednesday at 11 a. m. with Rev. Everett Cavin of Denver, Colo. officiating.

He is survived by his wife, Zada, three daughters, Nancy, Linda and Charlotte; three sons, John Jr., Glen and Daniel all at home in Rupert, Ida.; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Wm.
