Just below the hill was the homesteaded property where her father, Fred Fletcher, and his sisters were born. She rode her horse to catch the school bus to Guernsey, where she attended high school. She met and married James Evans and they had two children, Karen Kay born in 1941 and Martin Guy born in 1942. Marty passed away in 1946 and is buried in Brighton, Colorado. She and Jim Evans divorced. Dell and Kay lived in Denver. She married Francis Dudley McCann in 1956. She worked as a checker for Safeway stores until her retirement. After retirement they moved to Arkansas and then later to New Mexico. She and Dudley moved to Pueblo Colorado to be near Kay when their health started to fail. Dudley died in 2004 in Pueblo.
