

MCCARTNEY, BENJAMIN ELTIE

January 16, 1885-June 5, 1950

Funeral services for a long-time Kansas resident, Benjamin Eltie McCartney, 65, were held Wednesday at the Schrader's chapel. He died at his home west of Wheatland June 5.

Mr. McCartney was born January 16, 1885 at Cedar Bluffs, Kan. on the farm homesteaded by his parents. Living there for 61 years, he came to Wheatland four years ago.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Bessie M.
