October 14, 1972 – May 2, 2015

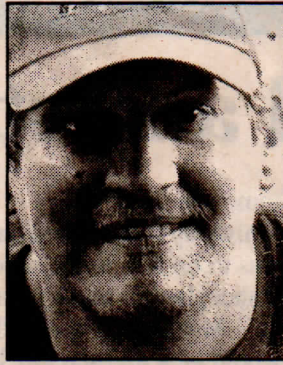
Jerry A. McCormick, 42, of Casper passed away after a car accident on May 2.
