

MCCULLOUGH, HARRIET ADELIA CUSHMAN

February 12, 1853-August 16, 1944

Funeral services will be held in the Congregational church Saturday at 2 p.m. for Mrs. Harriet Adelia McCullough, 91, of Guernsey, who died in the home of her daughter, Mrs. W.E. Regan, Wednesday at 8:15 a.m., following a long illness. The Rev. Clifford Higby will officiate.

Mrs. McCullough, widow of the late Charles H. McCullough, was born February 12, 1853, in Bangor, N.Y., and has been a resident of Platte county since 1884, residing on a ranch on Cottonwood for many years. She has made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Regan in Guernsey, for the past four years.

Besides Mrs. Regan, she is survived by another daughter, Mrs. C.R. Baker of Oak Creek, Colo.; two sons, Lloyd and Arthur of Anchorage, Alaska; ten grandchildren, eight great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
