

MCDONALD, JANE CAMERON
February 29, 1848-April 23, 1927

Funeral services for Mrs. Jane McDonald of Diamond, who had been in ill health for some time, who died Saturday night, April 23rd, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. E.R. Morrison, were held Wednesday afternoon in the Congregational church with Rev. D. Powell officiating. Watson Mortuary was in charge of the funeral arrangements. Mrs. McDonald had spent forty-seven years in Platte County.

Mrs. Jane (Cameron) McDonald was born February 29, 1848 in Ontario and died April 23, 1927 at Diamond, age 79 years. Coming to Wyoming in her youth, she married Donald McDonald in Cheyenne in 1880. To this union were born three sons and a daughter. Robert, a son, was killed at the Diamond Ranch in 1921 and a second son died during the World War in France. He husband died June 18, 1925. For the past few years, she has made her home with her daughter, Mrs. E.R. Morrison at Diamond. She leaves to mourn her loss, a daughter, Mrs. E.R.
