October 2, 1866-August 14, 1953

Funeral services were held on Tuesday, August 18, for Mrs. Mary L. McDowell, 86, of Wheatland, who passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Tom Mullin at the ranch northwest of Wheatland on August 14, following an extended illness.
