Graveside services for Samuel Edward McFarland, 91, who died Aug. 18, in Englewood, Colo. were held Monday, Aug. 22, with Dan Barcus officiating.

Samuel Edward McFarland was born Nov. 19, 1891, in Douglas. He spent his childhood years in the Douglas and Wheatland areas. He was in the service during World War I and upon his discharge returned to Wyoming.

He and Susie Eshom were married in Wheatland in 1928. After their marriage they were associated with Senator Carey in a ranching operation in Douglas. They returned to Wheatland and built the Shamrock Filling Station which they operated for several years. They then farmed on the Wheatland Flats for many years, moving to Idaho in 1948 and returning to Wheatland in 1970.

Survivors include two daughters, Lila Rigby of Cornelius, Ore.; Fern Harris of American Falls, Idaho, a son, Carl Race of Boise, Idaho, and two grandchildren and one great grandchild. He was preceded in death by his wife, Susie, in 1979, and by two brothers and a sister.

A memorial has been established to the Senior Citizen's Center.

Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
