SUNDAY

Deceased Lived Here For About 45 Years

Mrs. Agnes Oliver McFarlane, who has reside in the ranching coutry west of Wheatland for the past 45 years, died at the age of 77 years Sunday. Mrs. McFarland had been in poor health for the past four years and the latter three years she has been confined to her bed. She had lived at the E.A. Meade home during this time and it was at this place she passed away.

The deceased came here 45 years ago and since that time has lived here continuously. She was united in marriage to Dave McFarlane at the Owen ranch in 1904. She was born at North Bend, Wis., October 6, 1859. Her husband passed away Jan.2, 1928. She is survived by five grandchildren. Her daughter, Mrs. George Brandle, passed away in December, 1935. She is a sister-in-law to Mrs. Dave Cochrane.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon from the Lyla Watson Funeral Home. Rev. L.W. Fienner, pastor of the Congregational church preached the funeral sermon. Interment took place beside her husband in the Wheatland cemetery.
