Mrs. C.A. McFeron, who arrived from her home in Laward, Texas, about three weeks ago for a visit at the home of Mr. and Mrs. A.W. Wilson, of the Two Bar ranch, passed away Friday at the Wheatland Sanitarium. Mrs. McFeron had been in poor health for a number of years, and came here in hopes that the change in climate would prove beneficial, in which event the family figured on moving here. Mrs. McFeron's fight for health was in vain, however, as she was suffering from a complication of diseases, and death came when she was far from home and family.

The deceased was 34 years of age, and is survived by a husband and four children, Mr. McFeron being a brother of Mrs. Wilson.

Funeral services were held on Monday at the Congregational church by Rev. R.L. Paxton, and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery. The local Rebekah lodge attended the service in a body, holding their funeral services at the cemetery, the deceased having been a member of the Rebekah lodge at Bayard, Nebraska.
