

MCGILL, MERVYN MEREL
September 4, 1922-May 24, 1924

Mervyn Merel McGill, son of Mr. and Mrs. J.A. McGill, formerly of Greyrocks, was buried Sunday in the Wheatland cemetery, having died on Friday at Las Vegas while the family were enroute to their home here.

Mr. And Mrs. McGill and their two sons left here last summer for Phoenix to try the climate there for Mr. McGill's health, who was suffering from lung trouble as the result of injuries received in the World War. When the boy was taken seriously ill, he expressed a wish to return to the homestead, and the family set out by train.

They were met here by W.F. Brown who took them to their home at Greyrocks. Rev. Paxton conducted the funeral there Sunday morning, Misses Koreen Booth and Ruth Wickam accompanied him there and assisted in the song service.

The boy was two years and eight months at the time of his death.
