

MCGILL, NORA R. DODGE
April 11, 1886-May 27, 1939

Funeral services for Mrs. Nora Dodge McGill, 53, who passed away in Wheatland Thursday night, May 27, were held in Laramie on Sunday. Many from Wheatland were in attendance at the service.

Mrs. McGill, the daughter of the late Tyler Dodge and Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Dodge of Laramie, was born April 11, 1886, on a ranch near Duck Creek and was a life-long resident of Albany county. She was the wife of Thomas A. McGill, prominent Duck Creek rancher 70 miles north of Laramie.

Mrs. McGill's parents were pioneer settlers of Albany county, going there in 1885.

Mrs. McGill was active in many civic organizations. She was a member of the Laramie Dell club, the North Albany Community club and the Order of Eastern Star.

Surviving are her husband, two daughters, Mrs. Mary Johnston of Rifle, Colorado and Mrs. Agnes Turney of Laramie; one son, Owen; two grandchildren, Barbara Jean Johnston and JoAnn Turney; her mother, Mrs. Mary Dodge of Laramie and two brothers, Thomas and William A. Dodge, ranchers near Laramie.

Funeral services were held in the afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Presbyterian church. The Alpha Chapter No. 1 of the Eastern Star and the Presbyterian church had charge. A duet was sung by Mrs. Ben Cossman and Miss LoRene Watson of Wheatland.

Pallbearers were W.A. Dover of Wheatland; Charles A. Erne, C.D. Spaulding, G.R. McConnell, all of Laramie; A.S. Gillaspie, Rock River and Osa Mason, Centennial. Interment was made in the Laramie cemetery.
