

MCGINLEY, ELIZABETH JANIE SANDERSON
October 18, 1872-July 6, 1944

Funeral services were conducted by the Rev. W.W. Maxwell in the Schrader chapel, July 9, for Mrs. S.W. McGinley, who died Thursday evening, July 6, in her home. Mrs. Robert Kuns and Robert Barnes, accompanied by Mrs. J.A. Bohmont, sang. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Elizabeth Janie Sanderson, 72, was born in Peoria, Ill., on October 18, 1872. She came to Platte county in 1894 in a covered wagon with Mr. and Mrs. William Ayers and family, where she homesteaded. In September, 1897, she was united in marriage to S.W. McGinley in the Methodist parsonage, and one daughter was born to this union. She was affiliated with the Swedish Lutheran church.
