

Last rites held here Wednesday for Mrs. Paul McGrath

Funeral services were conducted at St. Patrick's Church Wednesday, June 8, for Mrs. Glenda Letitia McGrath, wife of Paul J. McGrath, Chugwater superintendent of schools, with Father Leonard Wren officiating. Rosary services were held Tuesday at 8:00 p. m. at the Schrader chapel.

Mrs. McGrath was born October 7, 1922 in Luray, Kans., and had lived the past year in Platte county where she taught school. She was a World War II veteran, serving with the U. S. Navy. Death came suddenly in her home at Chugwater on June 5.
