

MCGREW, ALTA PAULINE DAVIS
May 17, 1907-December 15, 1944

Mrs. James F. McGrew, 38, a former resident of Wheatland, died in the Memorial hospital in Cheyenne December 14 (?), following an eight month illness. She was brought to Wheatland by the Schrader Funeral Home and services were held in the Schrader Chapel Sunday at 2 p.m. Elders of the Latter Day Saints church in Scottsbluff officiated and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Alta Pauline Davis was born May 17, 1906 (?) in Wheatland where she attended the local schools graduating in 1925 from the Wheatland high school. She was united in marriage to James Felton McGrew on November 6, 1926 in Lusk, and to this union three children were born. She was affiliated with the Morman church.

Besides her husband, she is survived by three children, Eleanor Mae, Winnifred Ann and James J.; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jesse Davis; two sisters, Mrs. Gladys Morey of Cheyenne and Mrs. Wynette Watrous of Laramie; and four brothers, Shirley, Preston and Harris of Wheatland and Milton of the U.S. Navy.
