

MCGUIRE, VERA ELMIRA HIGHTOWER

Mass for Christian Burial for Vera Elmira McGuire, age 82, was held Friday, June 28 at 7:00 P.M at St. Patrick's Church in Wheatland with Father Malcolm Reid as Celebrant.

Penance services were held June 28 at 7:30 P.M. at St. Patrick's Catholic Church. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. McGuire passed away in Douglas on June 22.

She was born the daughter of Jack and Della May (Davis) Hightower in Wheatland on October 7, 1910. She was reared and educated in the Wheatland area. In 1925, she married P.J. "Pat" McGuire. The couple farmed in the Wheatland area until 1944 when they purchased the Muleshoe Ranch. In 1948, they purchased the Neely Ranch on Brush Creek, and lived there until their retirement in 1970, at which time they moved to Casper. At various times, they also lived in Glenrock and Douglas.

Mrs. McGuire is survived by one sister Wauneta Terry of Sheridan; two sons, Jack McGuire of Douglas and Fred McGuire of Wheatland; and a daughter, Maxine Cossman of Wheatland. Seven grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren also survive.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, one sister and her step-father, Frank Armann,
