

MCLEAN, WILLIAM DOWNIE
March 31, 1872-November 20, 1950

A pioneer resident of Wheatland, William Downie McLean, who has lived in this area since 1899, died en route to the hospital from his residence, 16 miles southeast of Wheatland.

He was born in Alwth, Scotland, March 31, 1872. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge at Chugwater, and the I.O.O.F. lodge of Wheatland.

A daughter, Miss Mary McLean of Slater, survives him; also three sisters, Mrs. Mary Sawyer of Denver, Mrs. Gene Yancey, of Windsor, Colo. And Mrs. Margaret Tullis of Cheopta, Kans.

Services were held at 2 p.m. in the Congregational church with Rev. W. James Hoare officiating. Funeral arrangements were handled by Schrader Funeral Home.
