

9-24 E.H. "Pete" McNall 1989

Funeral services for E. H. "Pete" McNall, 93, will be held at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 27, 1989 at the United Presbyterian Church with Reverend John Hall officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland, Wyoming cemetery with military rites by the Lake Guernsey Post #4471 of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. Memorial gifts to the Veterans Administration Center would be appreciated.

Mr. McNall died in the Veterans Administration Hospital in Cheyenne, Wyoming on September 24, 1989.

He was born February 2, 1896 at Morrison, Colorado, the son of George and Laura (Neal) McNall and he came to a homestead northwest of Guernsey in 1907. He received his education at the Etheridge School south of Guernsey. He served in France during World I; ninety days after leaving Wheatland he was fighting in the Argonne Forest. He and Marie Meadows were married at Gering Nebraska on June 2, 1920 and the couple made their home in Guernsey. He owned and operated the Conoco Station from 1925 until his retirement.

Mr. McNall gave a lifetime of service to his community. His various activities included the Guernsey Service Club; charter member of the Guernsey Lions Club; served on the Guernsey School Board, the Platte Memorial Hospital Board; the Town Council; Past Patron of O.E.S. and Past Master of Guernsey Lodge No. 49 A.F. & A.M. He was Mayor of Guernsey for 15 years. He was involved in many community activities over the years.
