

## Rose Ellen McPhee

Funeral services for Rose Ellen McPhee, age 74, will be held today (Wednesday, Jan. 10) at 11 a.m., at the Memorial Baptist Church in Wheatland, with Rev. Dennis Clermont officiating. Interment will follow in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. McPhee died Jan. 5, at the Alpine Manor Nursing home in Thornton, Colo., following a long illness.

Rose Ellen McPhee was born May 25, 1915, at Willow Springs, Mo., the daughter of William and Ellen (Bollinger) Garner. At an early age, the family moved to Kansas. In 1917, the family moved to Texas where she received her education.

In 1932, they moved to Horse Creek, Wyo. In 1933, she married Harvey Fisher in Kansas. Harvey and Rose raised their five children in Wyoming and Colorado.

Rose later married William McPhee in Cheyenne, Wyo., on Dec. 24, 1962. William died in 1975.

After her husband's death, Rose remained in the Chugwater area until 1985. At that time, she moved to Denver to be near her daughters. She was a rock hound and belonged to several different rock-hunting clubs.

She is survived by two daughters, Anna L. Velasquez and Peggy G. Winters, both of Denver, two sons, James H. Fisher of Houston, Tex. and William R. Fisher of Denver. Rose had seven grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents and husband, and one daughter, Nancy L. Crawford.
