Morgan McQuay passed away Saturday, Jan. 7, at the Platte Co. Memorial Hospital at the age of 95.

He was born Jan. 15, 1888 at Allepo. Penn. His parents died when he was a young boy and he came to Wyoming when he was 13 years old. He settled in the McFadden area and worked on a sheep ranch.

He later filed a homestead claim in McFadden which he operated until he entered the US Army during WW I. He served in the infantry in France and Germany during the war.

Upon his discharge from military duty, he returned to his homestead in McFadden. In recent years he retired to Wheatland where he started a small cattle operation west of town.

He was a member of the VFW and also a member of the McFadden Stock Growers Association.

He is survived by his wife, Christina of Wheatland, two daughters, Mary Cantwell of Wheatland and Julia Davis of Belleville, Wis.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a son, Lee, a daughter, Olive and five brothers and sisters. Surviving also are 13 grandchildren and numerous great grandchildren.

Services were held Mon. Jan. 9, at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Steve Dower officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery with military honors by the VFW Post of Guernsey.
