

MCQUISTEN, JAMES RICHARD

Services for James R. McQuisten, 78, who died in Wheatland, July 24, 1988, will be held in the Wheatland Bible Church at 2 p.m. today with Pastor Don Freeman officiating.

Born Sept. 29, 1909, in Merna, Neb., he was the son of David H. and Bertha (Bishop) McQuisten. He lived in Nebraska until the age of 18 at which time he moved to Wyoming where he worked for various farmers and ranchers.
