

MEMMER, CLARA MINERAVA YATES

March 13, 1859-October 19, 1932

Mrs. Clara M. Memmer, a resident of the Wheatland community since 1905, passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. James Irvine, who lives in the hills west of Wheatland, Wednesday morning at 9:45. Mrs. Memmer had suffered from acute attacks of indigestion at times, but lately her health was seemingly better than it had been in years. The night before her demise, she was up and around and apparently the best of health.

Mrs. Memmer was born March 13., 1858 and came to this country in 1905. Together with her husband and family settled on the farm on which the Natwick beet dump now stands. Her husband preceded her in death on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of this month, five years ago at the age of 75 years.

She has been a member of the Methodist church since early childhood and has been an active worker in that church. She joined the local church after coming here.

She is survived by seven children, three sons; Blaine and Franzel of Wheatland and Clair of Kansas City; four daughters; Mrs. Hattie Kelsey of Casper, Mrs. Bessie Irvine of Wheatland, Mrs. Ethel VanOsdol of Cedaredge, Colo. and Mrs. Iva Rhodes of Gilman, Iowa.

According to the Lyla Watson Funeral Home, who are in charge of arrangements, the funeral will be held Sunday afternoon at the Methodist church. Interment will take place in the Wheatland cemetery.
