Funeral services for Darlene Memmer, 93 will be held Saturday, September 12, 1992, at 10:30 A.M. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with the Reverend Karin E. Wade of All Saints Episcopal Church officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery with the Order of Eastern Star, Wheatland Chapter No. 11 conducting graveside rites.

Mrs. Memmer died Tuesday, September 8, 1992, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home after a lengthy illness.

She was born April 17, 1899, on a farm near Grinnell, Iowa, the daughter of Charles and Charlotte (Dee) Wolcott. She attended country school, Toledo High School, Cornell College at Mount Vernon, and Teacher's College at Cedar Falls, Iowa.

After teaching rural school in Iowa, she came west on a vacation and stayed in Wyoming to teach the Slate Creek School at the James E. Irvine Sr. ranch home.

She married Robert Blaine Memmer at the Irvine Ranch on December 24, 1925.

Darlene was a member of the United Methodist Church, W.S.C.S. (now called the United Methodist Women), W.T.K. Club, the American Legion Auxiliary, a past Noble Grand of the Rebekah's, a member of the Liberty Past Noble Grands, Eastern Star, and the Sew and So Club. Darlene was a talented artist and had a lovely soprano voice.

She is survived by her children; Ralph Memmer of Denver, Colo., Robert C. Memmer of Wheatland, and Jeanne Therkildsen of Casper.

Other survivors include a sister, Helen Wilson of Laguna Beach, Calif., eight grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert, on April 28, 1978, her parents, and three brothers.
