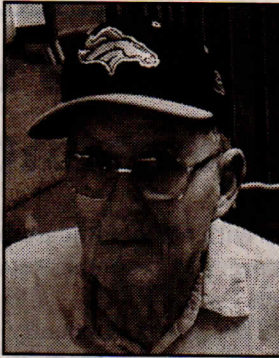


Jack Louis Michaelis
