

MICHAELIS, PEARL L. DUNHAM

July 13, 1888-May 5, 1967

Funeral services were conducted from the Schrader Chapel by Mr. Dale Scheffler at 2:00 p.m., May 8, 1967, for Pearl L. Michaelis, wife of L.H. Michaelis of Slater. Mrs. Michaelis passed away in the Platte County Memorial Hospital May 5, following a short illness.
