

MIDDAUGH, BETTY JEAN GERINGER

November 24, 1942-August 22, 1978

Betty Jean Middaugh died Tuesday, August 22, 1978, at Sheridan after an extended illness. She was 35. Pastor Emmet Rodness and Pastor Bernard Staake conducted services at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland, Saturday, August 26, 1978, at 10:00 a.m. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Betty was born and raised in Wheatland. She graduated from Wheatland High School in 1960 and worked as a secretary in Cheyenne and Casper. She met and married her husband, Ron, in Casper December 29, 1962. They moved to Laramie for a short time while Ron finished college at the University of Wyoming. The couple then moved to Beaver for two years and then moved to Sheridan where they made their home until the time of her death. She was a very active member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sheridan.
