Longtime resident, Agnes Mae Miller, 83, succumbed Tuesday, November 16, 1971 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital following an extended illness. A Platte County resident for 56 years, Mrs. Miller was born in Barnard, Missouri, May 1, 1888.

Married to Marion Bert Miller, they lived in Chugwater for a number of years. Five children were born to this union.

Mrs. Miller was affiliated with the First Baptist Church in Chugwater.
