Services for ⁶⁻⁵⁻¹⁹⁸⁵ Christina Marie Magdalina Miller, 82, who died in Wheatland, Wyoming June 5, 1985, were held Monday, June 10, in St. Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, at 2:00 p.m. with Father Malcolm Reid officiating. Rosary services were Sunday evening at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel at 7:00.

Marie Miller was born July 13, 1902, in Lincoln, Nebraska, the daughter of Phillip and Elizabeth Deinis Kniss. She spent her childhood in Lincoln. She and Fred J. Miller were married in Hastings, Nebraska, April 7, 1921. In 1930 they moved to Wheatland where they farmed until 1947 at which time they moved into town. She was District Vice-President of the V.F.W. and for many years was the pianist for the Moose Lodge and organist for St. Patrick Catholic Church.

She was a member of the Altar and Rosary Society, the Catholic Church, Royal Neighbors of America, Women of the Moose, Rebekah Lodge, and the V.F.W. Auxiliary.

Survivors include three sons: Edwin Miller and Wallace Miller, both of Laramie, Harvey Miller of Wheatland; two daughters: Ruby Dulitus of Illinois, Rosalie Cazier of Cheyenne; one sister, Rea Bolton of Loveland, Colorado, twelve grandchildren and eighteen great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
