Funeral services for Floyd Robert Miller, 91, were held Wednesday, Sept. 3, 1997 at 2 p.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Andy Gudahl, Minister officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Miller died Saturday, Aug. 30, 1997 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

He was born Aug. 22, 1906 in Seymour, Missouri the son of L.T. and Minnie (Ragsdale) Miller. He was reared and educated in the Seymour area. The family came to Wheatland in 1929, and stayed for a short time. They then moved to Nebraska, where they resided for seven years. In November, 1935 they returned to Wheatland, and he farmed with his brother, Pete, and their nephew Jack Miller joined them in 1958. He resided on the farm until 1979, and in his retirement years he worked for Greg Horton and Pat Cullen helping them in their farming operations. He enjoyed fishing and hunting. His nephew, Jack, lived with him for 50 years.

He is survived by his sister, Alma Franzen, of Wheatland; and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents; six sisters, and five brothers.
