October 10, 1898-November 5, 1966

An extended illness claimed the life of Frederick (Fred J.) Miller in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on November 5, 1966. He was born in Russia on October 10, 1898 and moved to this area in 1930, where he farmed until his retirement. He was married to Marie M. Kniss in Hastings, Nebr. on April 7, 1920 and was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church. In recent years, Mr. Miller had worked as a janitor for the Wheatland General hospital and the Stock Growers bank.
