

Services Held In Wheatland For John F. Miller

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon, Nov. 18 in the Schrader chapel in Wheatland for John F. Miller, 67 year old retired Platte county rancher who died at Evanston, Wyo., Thursday, Nov. 14, after an extended illness.

Born at Wendover Jan. 3, 1896, John Frederick Miller had lived there most of his life but he was well known throughout the county and lived for a time in Guernsey.

He was the son of Detlef F. W. and Charlotte S. Miller. His wife preceded him in death and his survivors include three sons, Richard D. of Douglas, Roland E. of Thermopolis and John F.
