

MILLER, LOU THORNTON
April 15, 1881-December 20, 1952

Lou Thornton Miller, age 72, who had farmed in the Wheatland vicinity since 1935, passed away at the local hospital December 20, 1952, following a long illness.

The deceased was born in Seymour, Mo. April 15, 1881, later living in Nebraska. He came to Wheatland 17 years ago.

Survivors include three sons, Floyd, Emmons and Oscar, all of Wheatland; three daughters, Mrs. Niece Hensley of El Mar, Calif., and Mrs. Arvid Johnson and Mrs. Einar Franzen, both of Wheatland.
