

Louise Kay Whittaker Miller

A funeral mass for Louise Kay Whittaker Miller, 72, was conducted at 11:00 A.M., Friday, July 2, 2010, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church, 1001 – 9th Street in Wheatland, Wyoming.
