Services for Richard David Miller, 66, who died in Evanston April 19, were held at 10 a. m. Monday at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating.

Miller was born June 13, 1918 in Guernsey, the son of John F. and Helen Miller. He spent his childhood in the Guernsey area.

After school, in 1936, he went to Lander and worked on various ranches.
