Robert Miller

Robert R. "Bob" Miller, 79, a resident of Cedaredge for the past nine years, died at 5:25 a.m. Thursday, Feb. 26, 1987, in Delta County Memorial Hospital following a long illness.

Mr. Miller had ranched in Wyoming and Montana. After his retirement in 1972, he lived at Casper, Wyo., before moving to Cedaredge in 1978.

Born Dec. 20, 1907, at Casper, a son of Z.Q. and Pearl E. Kingston Miller, he spent his childhood at Casper and graduated from Casper High School in 1925. He attended college at Lincoln, Neb., a year and at Laramie, Wyo., a year.

His wife is the former Edna Marie Baumgardner, whom he married at Laramie May 15, 1936.

Mr. Miller was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity. He enjoyed working with livestock and horses.

Besides his wife, he is survived by a son, Marvin Ray Miller of Butte, Mont.; a daughter, DeeVon Miller of Cedaredge; two sisters, Lola Maier of Coral Gables, Fla., and Irene Harris Beck of Casper; and three grandchildren.

Preceding him in death were a son, Maier Quinn Miller, in 1973, and a brother, Leo Miller.

Family memorial services are to be held later. Cremation has taken place.
