

Fonda B. Million

October 12, 1919 – December 17, 2005

Graveside service to honor the memory of Fonda B. Million, 86, will be held 2 p.m. Saturday, June 10 at the Wheatland Cemetery. Fonda passed away Dec. 17, 2005 in Glendale, Ariz.

Mrs. Million was born October 12, 1919 and raised in Payne, Iowa. She married William "Martin" Million. After many years together, they moved to Wheatland in 1958. Fonda and Martin were the parents of seven children, (six boys and a girl). After the death of her husband in 1961, at the young age of 42, Fonda continued alone to raise their children, with the help from many generous people in Wheatland. In 1974, she lost her middle child, Jesse, to a tragic accident, when he was 23. In 2001 Fonda lost another son, Larry (second oldest) to heart disease at the age

of 55. Fonda moved from Wheatland to Glendale in 2001.

Fonda suffered many losses over her 86 years including the loss of a leg from her battle with diabetes. One thing that kept her going though was her love for her children.

Fonda is survived by her five remaining children: Steven of Salt Lake City, Utah, Michael of Los Vegas, Nev., Tad of Loveland, Colo., Richard of Phoenix, Ariz., and RoseAnn Rinne of Cheyenne, and her grandchildren and great grandchildren.
