

MILLS, FRANCES ELIZABETH NAFTSINGER

May 21, 1860-October 31, 1925

Mrs. William Henry Mills, resident for 14 years on the Laramie river west of Uva, passed away Saturday, October 31st, and was buried in the Wheatland cemetery Tuesday afternoon.

Mrs. Mills was one of the best known residents of the Uva and Dwyer districts, with a wide circle of relatives and friends who mourn her departure.

Her maiden name was Frances Elizabeth Nafsinger and she was born on May 21st, 1860 in Adams County, Ohio. In early childhood, she moved with her parents to Yorktown, Ind. On June 15, 1882, she was united in marriage to William Henry Mills. To this union were born seven children, one of whom died in infancy, and another, the eldest, dying in early manhood. She leaves to mourn her departure, two daughters, Ruth Wyman of Wheatland and Bertha Mills of Midwest; two sons, John Mills of Anderson, Ind. and Luther and Roger Mills of Wheatland. She is also survived by 14 grandchildren, an aged father and two sisters, Mrs. Mary L. Richmond of Portland, Ore. and Mrs. Lily M. Rinker of Uva.
