

MILLS, LOUIE LAVINIA SHARP

April 28, 1888-February 4, 1977

Services were held for Louie Lavinia Mills Tuesday, February 8, 1977, at the First Christian Church with Mr. Daniel Barcus officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Mills passed away at the age of 88 at Platte County Memorial Hospital Friday, February 4, 1977.

Mrs. Mills was born in Muncie, Indiana April 28, 1888. She married Luther Mills November 22, 1908 in Indiana. She had been a resident here since 1911 when she and her husband homesteaded in Uva and farmed there until 1958 at which time they retired to Wheatland.

She was a member of the First Christian Church, Dwyer's Homemaker's Club and the Mothers Home Club in Wheatland.
