

MILTON, CLISTA ELNOZA ARMSTRONG
July 1, 1895-March 6, 1976

A former resident of Wheatland, Mrs. Clista Milton, died Saturday, March 6, 1976, at the Riverton Memorial Hospital. Funeral services were held Monday, March 8, 1976 at the Wheatland United Methodist Church. Rev. Jerald Van Leuven of Cheyenne presided over the services. Burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Guy E. Milton, Harold Dwain Carey, Waldo Moorehouse, Wayne A. Milton, Clair H. Milton, Jr. and Vern Charles Milton, all grandchildren, served as pallbearers. Funeral arrangements were made by the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home.

Mrs. Milton was born July 1, 1895 at Waterloo, Nebraska to William W. and Naomi Armstrong. She grew up in Eastern Nebraska living with her parents at Fremont Valley and Waterloo. She was united in marriage to Guy E. Milton on August 21, 1913 in Omaha, Nebraska.

The family moved to a ranch between Wheatland and Guernsey in April of 1921 where her husband died of cancer July 9, 1939. She later lived in Wheatland, Lingle, Torrington, Cheyenne, and three years in Colorado Springs before moving to Lander in 1969.

She entered the Fremont Manor Nursing Home in February 1972 where she resided until her death.

She is survived by three sons, Clair H. Milton of Cheyenne, Gale E. Milton of Lander, and Harold E. Milton of Riverside, Calif.; by three daughters, Mrs. Edna Moorhouse of Colorado Springs, Colo., Mrs. Inez Ilicks of Denver, Colo., and Mrs. June Carey of Gering, Nebr.; a brother, Hiram Clifford Armstrong of Waterloo, Nebr.; and 14 grandchildren and 30 great grandchildren.
