

Doyle Earl Missildine

April 11, 1966-June 3, 2002

Funeral services for Doyle Earl Missildine, 36, were held June 12 at the First Christian Church in Wheatland with Andy Gudahl, Minister, officiating. Interment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Missildine died Monday, June 3, 2002, at United Medical Center-West in Cheyenne.

Doyle was born April 11, 1966, in Houston, Tex., the son of Doyle and Sussan (Visser) Missildine Sr. He was reared and educated primarily in Nebraska, graduating from high school in Maywood, Nebr. in 1983. After high school, he received automotive training in Laramie, and later trained in masonry work. Doyle worked in Nebraska and Wyoming, moving to Cheyenne in 1988. He married Evlynn "Lynn" Gudahl on May 6, 1995, in Wheatland. He owned his own remodeling and construction business and then did maintenance work for Super 8 Motel and The Hitching Post Inn in Cheyenne.

He enjoyed hunting and fishing and was an excellent cook and baker.

Doyle is survived by his wife, Evlynn "Lynn" Missildine of Cheyenne; mother, Sue Doyle and husband, Clyde of Cheyenne; a daughter, JoLynn Gaddis and husband, Jade of Wilber, Nebr.; two grandchildren, T.J. and A.J. Gaddis both of Willard; mother-in-law, Mary Etta Dannar of Wheatland; grandmother-in-law, Evelyn Walter of Wheatland; and two nephews, Russell Kriefels of North Platte, Nebr. and Wesley Kriefels of Wilber.

He was preceded in death by his father.
