

Richard Edgar Moede

November 16, 1929-August 22, 2000

Services for Richard Edgar Moede, 70, were held Saturday, Aug. 26, 2000 at 2 p.m. at the Covenant Lutheran Church in Wheatland, with Pastor Paul Ward officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery Thursday, Aug. 31, at 2 p.m., with the Wyoming Air National Guard Flag Heritage Team conducting military graveside rites.

Mr. Moede died Tuesday, Aug. 22 at Robertson, Wyo.

He was born Nov. 16, 1929 in Red Cloud, Neb., to the late John T. and Minnie F. (Gurney) Moede. He was reared and educated in country grade schools near Red Cloud, and attended and graduated from the Inavale High School in Inavale, Neb. in 1948. He came to Laramie, Wyo. in 1949, and then to Wheatland to join his family in 1950.

He served in the United States Air Force from January, 1952 to June, 1953, during the Korean Conflict. Following his discharge he returned to Wheatland where he worked at various jobs. The past 15 years he has been involved in the trucking business. He was married to Margaret Jessen on Aug. 4, 1957, in Wheatland, then was married to Jane Dinges on April 21, 1964 in Scottsbluff, Neb., and was married to Jeanne M. (Wade) Stotler on Aug. 31 1996 in Wheatland.

He enjoyed hunting, fishing, bowling and attending his children and grandchildren's sport-

ing events. He was a past member of the Moose Lodge, and was a member of the Wheatland Country Club.

He is survived by his wife, Jeanne Moede of

Wheatland; five children, Sharon and husband Dail Dozier of Laramie, Carolyn and husband John Redding of Wheatland, Amy Boling of Tacna, Ariz. Donnie and wife Lauri Moede of Wheatland and Kail Moede of Wheatland; four stepsons, Gary and Jacob Stotler of Wheatland and Bob and Rex Tillman of Wheat Ridge, Colo.; one sister, Erma Moede of Wheatland; and 13 grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by two wives, Margaret Jessen Moede and Jane Dinges Moede; one brother, William Moede and one grand-
